What is happening with the Safeway site?

Our village supermarket closed in July, 2018, which is getting close to five years ago. It was May/June 2022 when the community last heard from the developer, BentallGreenOak, at the open houses showing the proposed plans. Following the open houses, BGO was instructed to work with City of Vancouver staff before showing any more plans to the community.

Friends of Point Grey Village asked City staff for an update on the project, but so far there has been no response. We also asked BentallGreenOak and were told that the company continues to meet and discuss next steps with City staff. No timeline was given of the future development review process.

ABC swept the recent municipal elections. You will recall that ABC is on record to support the following on the Safeway site:

- New purpose-built library
- Daycare
- Public Square

ABC also supports redesigning 10th Avenue with People First policies.

In the meantime, BentallGreenOak says that soil remediation is progressing well and that they expect to finish this process by the end of March. They have been evaluating possible temporary uses for the site but have not yet made a decision on whether there is a workable option.

The only thing we can say for sure that will happen on the site in the near future is that the Grade 7 students at Queen Elizabeth School have been working hard to provide beautiful art to be hung on those white hoardings. We look forward to enjoying the art while we await our new village development.

Will the new supermarket in the University Endowment Lands impact the viability of a future supermarket in the village?

As many of you will have noticed by now, an Urban Fare has opened in the University Endowment Lands, as part of the Lelam development. Opening day was February 3, 2023. Interesting that at Lelam, streets can be laid out, hundreds of condos can be built and occupied and a 15,000 square foot

supermarket can be built and opened, all the while that our Safeway site remains vacant. These are two separate political jurisdictions and two separate developers/owners, with different motivations.

Will the presence of a nearby supermarket impact the potential of a full service supermarket on the Safeway site in the future? When asked this question at the May/June 2022 open houses, BentallGreenOak staff stated that their retail market analysis showed that a 38,000 square foot supermarket could be supported on the Safeway site even though they expected a supermarket to open soon at Lelam. The 38,000 square feet store being proposed is about 50% bigger than the old Safeway. UEL planning studies specified that the new supermarket should primarily serve north campus and Lelam, and also potentially ease some pressure on the overly busy Save On Foods in South Campus.

So the short answer is no—the Urban Fare should not impact the viability of our future supermarket.

Library update

Work is happening at the old VanCity building at **4566 West 10th**—the new location of the **Point Grey Library**. Workers on site say the plan is for work to be finished and the library moved in by the end of June.
