
Safeway Site Development Update

In our [October 2023 newsletter](#), Friends of Point Grey Village presented ideas to help improve the developer's revised proposal for the Safeway site. The second BentallGreenOak proposal was shown to the community in June 2023. City staff is evaluating the second BGO proposal now. The next chance for community comment will likely be at a City-sponsored Open House in a few months. We will let you know the date when it is announced.

Our goal is to make sure the future development works well for the community, local businesses, and the developer. It is an excellent opportunity to help

implement the newly adopted Vancouver Plan and show the many benefits of strong, prosperous neighbourhood villages.

Many Creative Design Improvements are Possible



We asked our readers if they had any comments on the ideas presented and we got plenty of feedback. Thank you! Some of these comments are provided below. We look forward to working with the City and the developer in the coming months.

Some comments from our readers:

"Thank you for all the work you have done on this....the proposals are very creative. They illustrate the possibilities for creating a welcoming community-oriented space."

“A permanent home for the library on this site would be a tremendous asset for the existing community and new residents. I feel it would add enduring value, vitality and a special quality to the entire site, bringing long term dividends to the developer too. The example you gave of the joint venture of the developer and the municipality in Sydney, Australia is very inspiring. I think this is what Mayor Sim meant by getting Vancouver’s swagger back.”

“For us, the second kick at the proposed design was a huge disappointment. The two main towers crowd into West 10th. There are no decks or staggered stories providing access to unobstructed sky. Just basic apartment living atop a huge grocery store. I would really like to see a return to the first drawings, or some re-imagining of the towers that would provide tenants with decks rather than balconies.”

“We really would like to see forward progress on this development.... West 10th is slowly becoming a retail desert without the central anchor.”

“I can’t imagine this boring, fortress-like development being showcased in Sun Life’s future Annual Reports. Please architects, show some flair, imagination and respect for the village setting.”

“I support larger sidewalks and some reasonable public space. The “parklet” on Sasamat has been a good addition to the neighbourhood. A centre courtyard is a great idea.”

“I support the addition of a child care and library and look forward to the City

finding ways to fund these important community facilities.”

“Bravo to the community for this info and insight.”

Now is the time to consider these improvements. By the time the public hearing occurs, City staff and Council will have already made up their minds.

Community Garden and Dog Park Come to the Village

BentallGreenOak (BGO) has decided to use the Safeway site for a dog park and community garden as interim use while going through the development approval process. We are pleased that this vast open space is getting some community use. Neighbourhood dogs are enjoying the off-leash frolic close to home. We understand that gardeners have leased out all of the 130 garden boxes and some plants are already sprouting.

BentallGreenOak is eligible to apply to reclassify the property from Class 6 “Business” to Class 8 “Recreational Property/Non-Profit Organizations” as a result of providing this interim use. This reclassification will result in a significant reduction in property taxes made possible through provincial legislation.

Sasamat Parklet

The parklet has had some improvements recently including a water fountain for humans and a lower one for the puppers, a solar powered seating area, and some new seating.



